

## **CT318 Human Computer Interaction 2023-2024 Module Expectations:**

### **Lecturer's Responsibilities:**

- Provision of course outline and marking scheme
- Provision of environment (materials, assignments) to facilitate student learning
- Preparation and presentation of weekly lecture material with an indication of links to other course material to facilitate learning
- Provision of additional relevant references on material covered
- Preparation of assignments and provision of specific deadline

### **Students' Responsibilities:**

### **Canvas Module Orientation:**
