- Power point presentation You may use other format that you are comfortable with If, power point is not available (e.g., keynotes, screen recording tools, etc).
- Refer to the lecture videos in Week 2 to help you structure your presentation You should consider all the main elements required for a successful presentation, and you can also include optional elements (as discussed in the lecture "Bringing it all together"). Additionally, you can add your own flair to your videos (but maintain professionalism).
- Refer to the "Detoxing" presentation outline as guide You can find a sample presentation structure in the lecture video discussing the "Detoxing" topic. You can use the video as a guide (or baseline) to structure your presentation.



The Report:

- Discuss the preparation and planning processes
 You MUST consider the 6 questions as discussed in the lecture video (emphasise on MUST).
- Discuss your presentation structure
 You should show examples of your Introduction, middle part and conclusion.
- Discuss your audience
 You should describe your target audience (e.g., colleagues, students, customers, etc)
- Additional factors

You should mention any additional factors that might be relevant to your presentation which were not mentioned in the lecture video but necessary in order to useful to your target audience.
